Dover Inland Border Facility Update

I am writing to inform you that there have been some slight changes and additional information added to the proposal plan which is present on both the leaflet and the website. We have also added additional clarity regarding the likely types of document checks being carried out which includes consignments covered by the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora (CITES) and market surveillance. These have arisen due to further development of our proposals. Therefore, to reflect these updates the period to submit comments has been extended to 23:59 on 17th November 2021.
